Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that on Wednesday 24th April Year 3 will be going on a visit to the **RHS Gardens at Harlow Carr, Harrogate** as an integral part of our science work all about plants.

We will be leaving school at **9:15am** prompt, so please ensure your child arrives at school no later than **8:45am**. We will spend the morning attending an expert-led workshop all about pollination and how plants grow. Each child **must wear their school jumpers** but are allowed to wear **comfortable trousers** (e.g. tracksuit bottoms). They will also need to bring a **packed lunch and water bottle**, all of which should be carried in a rucksack.
