The children have been working on these dances as part of a Year 5 and 6 dance competition being organised by North Yorkshire Sport. The children have considered what they want to wear for the event; some are happy to wear normal P.E. kit, others are adding in a coloured t-shirt from home and others are planning to wear some of schools Saltergate coloured P.E. kits worn for competitive events.

On the day of the event, which is Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April, from 1pm onwards, our School Games Organiser from North Yorkshire Sport will be coming into school to film the children's dances. It will then be judged and all videos will be deleted once all the decisions have been made. This may take some time as the judges will also be watching videos from other schools. All judges are DBS checked and work either in local schools or at North Yorkshire Sport.

Please be reassured that none of the material will go onto social media except any photos or videos that school staff may take on the day. These will be shared in accordance with permissions given by you as parents and carers.

North Yorkshire Sport are trying new ways of engaging children in competitive activities to enable participation, confidence and equal opportunities, which is why they are coming into school to film the dance instead of relying on the schools/parents to transport their children to events, which is not always possible. This way every child can take part in the event and experience a positive competition situation. If on the day, your child decides that they do not want to participate in the event, this would not be an issue and they can watch the other children perform their dances.
