Mobile Technology

Pupils in Year 5 and Year 6 are permitted to bring mobile phones to school. They must be handed in to a member of staff who will place them in a locked box. We recognise that some of our Y5 and Y6 pupils may be travelling to school by themselves and/or are young carers who need to be contactable.

Smart Watches

We have made the decision that pupils are not permitted to bring smart watches to school. This is because:

Smart watches can be valuable items and might render a pupil vulnerable to theft. They can make pupils objects of envy and could have implications with regard to discipline and potential bullying. Even when apparently silent, smart watches can potentially undermine classroom discipline and distract pupils' learning. Some smart watches have integrated cameras which could lead to child protection and data protection issues with regard to inappropriate capture, use, or distribution of images. Please support us in following this policy and explaining this to your child.

Healthy Snacks

Children in KS2 are invited to bring in healthy snacks for break time. We would prefer this to be fruit, breadsticks, rice cakes or other healthy items and would rather that they did not bring crisps and chocolate for snack time. Tuck is no longer available to purchase due to lack of interest.

Children in Discovery Learning, Reception and KS1 will be offered fresh fruit and vegetables as previously.



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Sun cream and hats

The forecast is set to be very warm this week, please remember to apply sun cream to your children before school and ensure that they bring a hat.

Water Bottle

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle, however, please do not use 'Prime' bottles.

Pencil Cases

There is no expectation for KS2 students to bring a pencil case to school and stationery will be provided as needed. However, they may bring a pencil case if they wish to do so; these will be kept in the under-desk trays.
