What is your favourite fruit?
What is your favourite vegetable? What colour is an apple/carrot etc? Is an apple etc a fruit or vegetable? Tell me something about a carrot etc.

What do we need to know?

Fruit

* Apples are red or green and grow on trees.
* Oranges are orange and grow on trees.
* Bananas are yellow and grow on trees.
* Strawberries are red and grow on a plant.

Vegetables

* Carrots are orange and grow in the ground.
* Potatoes are white and grow in the ground.
* Peas are green and grow on a plant.
