

Statement of Behaviour Principles

This statement emphasises the values that are held by the schools and which we promote to all members of the school family.

- We look after our school and everyone in it

As children move into KS2, we emphasise the 5 R's:

- Responsible
- Resilient
- Resourceful
- Respectful
- Reflective

These are the cornerstone of the attitudes and ethos of Saltergate. We believe that if we all embody these values, our school community will be happy, safe and strong.

At Saltergate, we take a restorative approach to issues that occur and teach our children to adopt a reflective mindset. This enables the development of understanding, of positive relationships and respect for both ourselves, and others.
