
Must- I must know and be able to use the Autumn vocabulary. Should- I should be able to recall things that happen in Autumn.

What do we need to know about Autumn?

Autumn is one of 4 seasons- Winter, Spring, Summer, Autumn.

The days get shorter (it gets dark earlier).

Squirrels collect nuts.

Leaves change colour and fall from the trees.

Conkers fall from a horse chestnut tree.

Acorns fall from an oak tree.

Fruits ripen eg blackberries, apples.

Hedgehogs get ready to hibernate.

The weather gets colder and we have to wear warmer clothes.

Some birds fly to warmer countries.
