Must: I must be able to count and recognise numbers to 5
Should: I should be able to recognise the correct amount or find the correct amount for a given number Could: I could say 2 numbers that make another number e.g 3+2=5

- * Going on a number hunt, how many numbers can you spot/take photos of?
- * Making different amounts with items you have at home
- * Write some number sentences or draw some pictures of number pairs

Key Questions

Which group has more/less/most/least? Which number comes before/after? If I have 3, how many more do you need to make 5?

Which two numbers make 5?

What do we need to know about Maths?

Counting 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

The order of the numbers. Which number comes before, which number comes after.

Say which group has more/less, the most/the least, greater/fewer.

Say/choose a number and find the correct amount of objects.

Know that 2 numbers together make another number, at least all numbers to 5, and some up to 10. E.g 2+3=5, 4+1=5, 4+3=7, 5+5=10
