#### **Clubs on MCAS**

It is now possible to see what clubs your child is registered for on the My Child At School App (MCAS). Please log in if you have not received the automatic email confirmation. We will be using this for all clubs going forward.

If you do not have access to MCAS, please download the app and click 'Forgot my password'. Enter the email address we have for you in school and reset your password. If this does not work, please speak to the school office who can help.

#### Wellies

As it is bad weather, if you wish to send your child to school in wellies, please ensure they are named and stored in a bag during the day so school shoes can be worn through the day.

#### **Parking**

Just a gentle reminder to NOT park on the driveway into school. We've had numerous occasions of vehicles unable to access the school site because of cars parked on the double yellow lines, especially at the beginning and end of each day. Traffic Wardens patrol this area and will issue penalty notices for any vehicle seen parked on double yellow lines.

This is especially important to ensure access for emergency vehicles, as cars blocking the driveway would stop an emergency vehicle accessing the school site in an emergency and waste vital time.



Hello all Parents, Grandparents & Guardians,

Firstly, a big thankyou to those parents & children who asked how I was, after my Covid illness recently - I am grateful for your concern.

Can I ask everyone who walks with, or drives their children to & from school,

or where children of years 5 & 6 can walk on their own, to be especially careful as they cross the roads - both Harewood, & Newby Crescent; as even this week there have been a couple of close-calls as children have crossed when traffic is approaching. I know children are eager to get to school, but it's better to let a car pass-by rather than dash out in front of it.

The driver may not be able to stop as quickly as you think! Please instruct the children to look in both directions before they cross any road.

With the younger children, it is vital to take their hand or arm & walk with them across the road, rather than let them run ahead across the road.

Finally, when getting children out of or into the car, can you try to do so on the side nearest the kerb & not into the road, please. I've seen some parents open the door behind them & let the child out into the road without looking for traffic when a car is about to pass them. Watch what is going on around you before opening the door & letting your child out!

I am only concerned about your child's safety. I have no control over other drivers, especially where traffic is nothing to do with school.
