The War of the Roses

22 August 1485

Henry Tudor won the Battle of Bosworth Field

28th June 1491

Henry VIII was born

21 April 1509

Henry VII died

24 June 1509

Henry VIII was crowned king

18 February 1516

Mary I was born

7 September 1533

Elizabeth I was born

12 October 1537

Edward VI was born

28 January 1547

Henry VIII died

20 February 1547

Edward VI was crowned king

6 July 1553

Edward VI died

1 October 1553

Mary I was officially crowned queen

17 November 1558

Mary I died at St. James's Palace

15 January 1559

Elizabeth I was crowned queen

24 March 1603

Elizabeth I died

29 July 1567

James VI of Scotland, was crowned king
