Must: I must know the names of some of the famous landmarks in London.

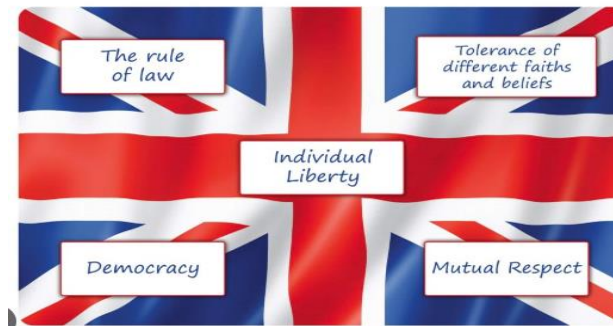
Should: I should know about some of the human and physical features of London. I should know the 5 British values.

BRITISH VALUES



Key Vocabulary

Landmark: An easily recognisable feature of a landscape.

Physical Feature: A natural feature, such as a hill or river.

Human Feature: A man-made feature, such as a building or a road.

British Values: A set of 5 values which are important to follow.
