Friday 28th June will be Year 3's Egypt Day! Children are welcome to come as an Egyptian, an archaeologist or in your own clothes or school uniform.

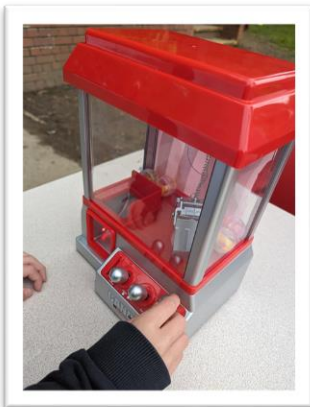
Year 2 Visit to The Sculpture Park
