Bright Class – The children have enjoyed doing maths dot-to-dots, making numbers lines and looking for number patterns. Super extra mile work!

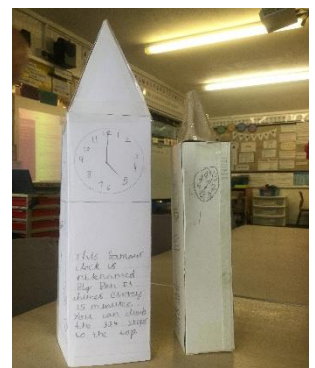


Jeffers Class – Lots of extra mile this week from the new Maths knowledge organiser. Well done, Jeffers class!

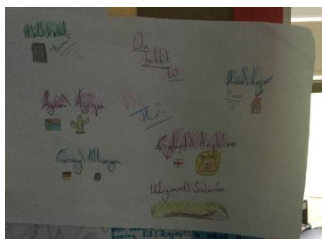


Morpurgo Class – Have been working their socks off with their extra mile work this week learning all about the digestive system. Super learning everybody!

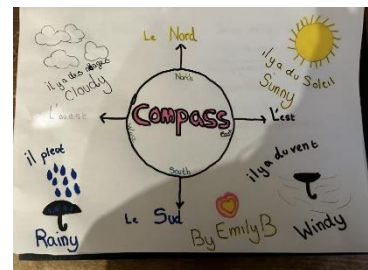

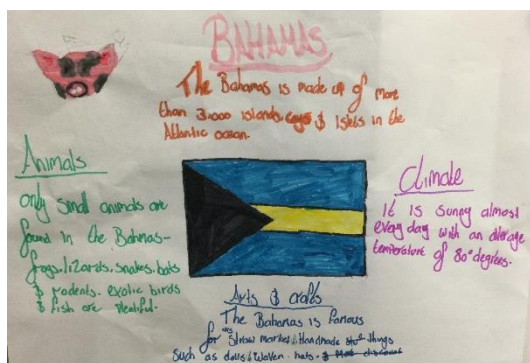

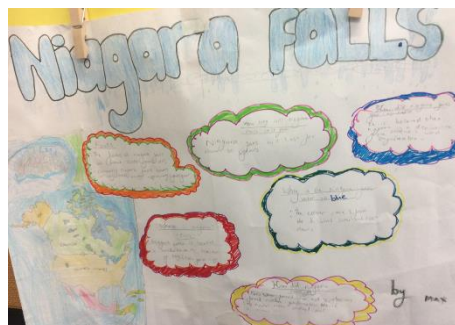
Potter Class – Harris made this fantastic French translation sheet.
