


Bright Class – No extra mile this week.


Year 2




Percival Class – Lots of extra mile work this week from our Easter Knowledge Organiser. Well done Percival Class. It was lovely to share your gorgeous work




Dahl Class – What a fantastic sketch during our geography field work earlier this week. Instructions followed, sketch completed and wonderful annotations! Well done!




Walliams Class – A brilliantly detailed field sketch from our Geography learning this week. This has been completed beautifully by paying close attention to the instructions that were given during the lesson!

Morpurgo Class – We have been learning all about the Christian festival of Easter- super learning!




