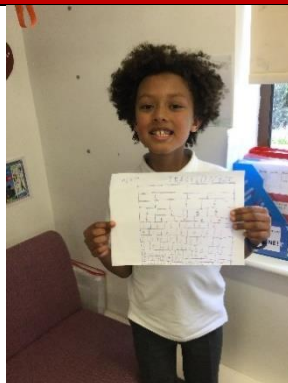
Year 2

Year 4

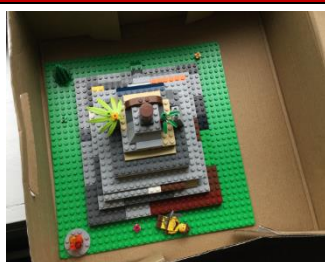


Morpurgo Class – have been mathematical whizzes this week using their knowledge to create to go the extra mile.
