Percival- The children have loved creating extra mile work this week for our Coronation Knowledge Organiser. Well done Percival class, fantastic work

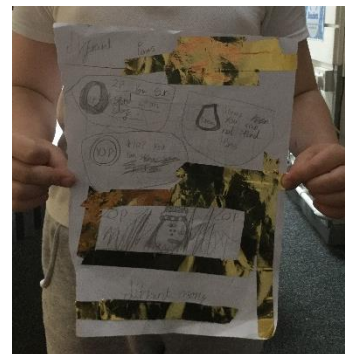

Year 3

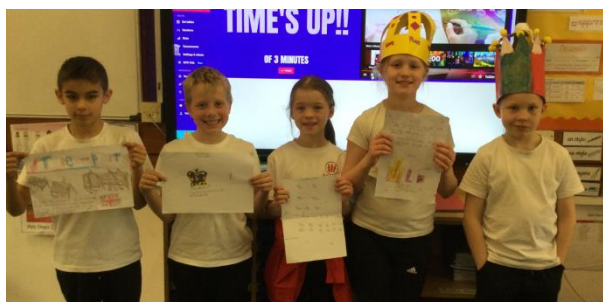


Dahl Class – these delightful Coronation biscuits were certainly fit for a king! Tasty and beautifully decorated crowns – super ‘extra mile’ work!

Morpurgo- We have gone coronation crazy this week making things to celebrate our new monarch King Charles III. Super work everyone!

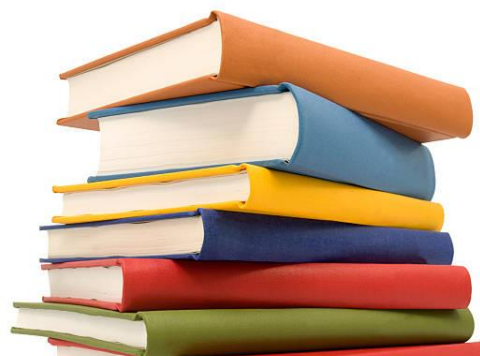


Rowling - Many of our children enjoyed celebrating the coronation last weekend! One of our children developed his food technology skills and made a trifle! It looked delicious!
