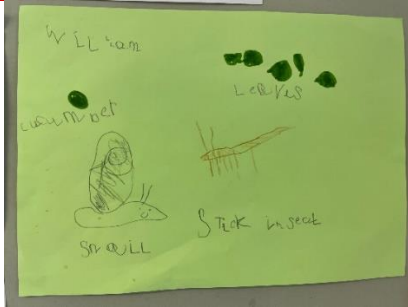

Year 2

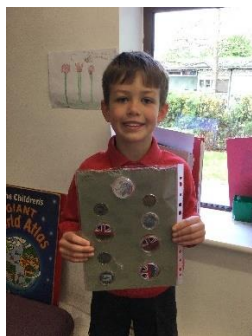


Percival- We haven't had any extra mile work this week, but Freddie shared with us some work he created about his trip to Barcelona. Well done Freddie it was really interesting.

Year 3

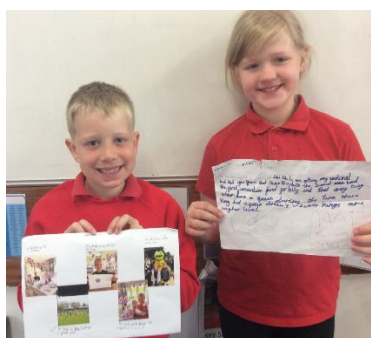

Jack made this fantastic 'traditional' Mayan person.

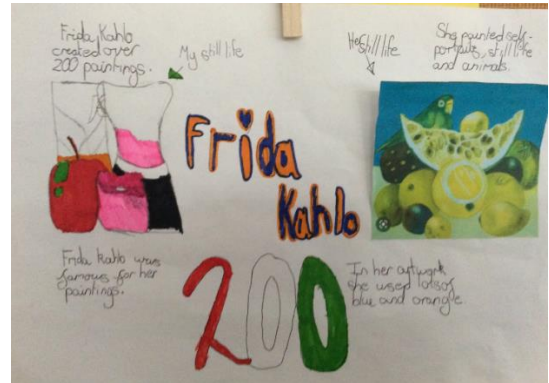
