Year 1

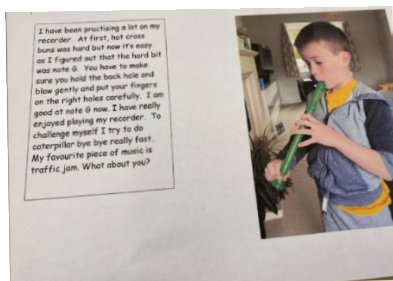

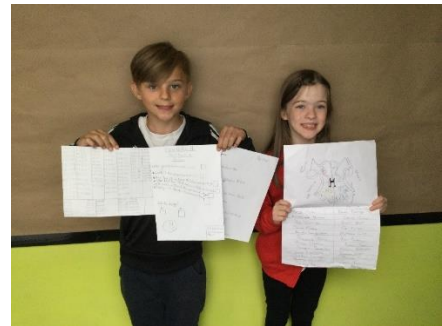


Walliams - No 'Extra Mile' this week but we have worked really hard in school and are settling back into our routines! It has been lovely to hear about all the fun had in half term!
