


Our Routine

Sometimes we will stay for lunch. We all eat together and the grown-ups will be there to help you become independent.

We will learn to use the toilet all by ourselves. We must flush the toilet and wash our hands carefully with soap. The adults in the nursery will check throughout your session to see if you need help.
