This term the children across the Infant school have had various opportunities to increase their levels of physical activity and improve their skills in physical education. Some of these opportunities were:

- Sports days in EYFS and KS1 with help from the Year 6 Sports Crew

Extra-Curricular Sport Clubs

This term the children across Key Stage 1 have had the opportunity to take part in a Multi-club, which involved some physical activity as well as Move it, Mini Me ran by Mrs Kennedy.

Both clubs have allowed the children attending these clubs to be physically active in a number of ways including using the bikes and scooters and ribbon dancing. The percentage of children who have attended a PE club in Key Stage One is 61%, with 62.79% in Year 1 and 55.56% in Year 2.

There will hopefully be some more PE clubs in the Autumn Term.



P.E. Lessons across the Infant School

Children across the Infant school have had lots of fun developing their fine and gross motor skills in their PE lessons taught by their adults.

The lessons have ranged from multi-skills using the Real PE programme, climbing using the gym apparatus, riding the bikes and scooters and the Premier Martial Arts sessions.

The children do love their PE lessons and cannot wait for the Autumn term, where they will be using the new PE programme from the PE Hub.



Forest School in KS1 and Adeola Class

Children in KS1 and Adeola Class have had the lovely opportunity to attend Forest Schools every week with Born of the Forest. Each class has had the chance to have a go in the forest area and have had a great time.

They have taken part in lots of fun activities such as cooking, arts and crafts, den building as well as using the rope swings and balance ropes.

The children are super excited for their forest school lessons to continue next year.



Free taster sessions with Premier Martial Arts

This term after the success of our paid sessions with Oliver from Premier Martial Arts last year, Oliver and his coaches were kind enough to offer some more free 30-minute taster sessions across the whole school, from Adeola Class in Reception, to the Key Stage One classes and all of the classes in Key Stage Two. Oliver has once again been a huge success and all the children have loved taking part in his sessions. He taught the children how to keep themselves safe, how to defend themselves as well as learning about respect and using what they have learnt in an appropriate manner and place (i.e. only in the lessons and when an adult gives permission, and not on the playground).

A massive thank you to Oliver and his team, the children have loved every minute, we look forward to working with Oliver again in the future.



Sports Day 2026

The children in KS1 and reception enjoyed their sports day on the Junior field and the infant running track taking part in lots of different activities.
